Guidelines

- Interested individuals need to submit an email stating their intent to stand for nomination by **March 20, 2019** to GNAO Past-President, Julie Rubel (julie.rubel@gmail.com).
- As per GNAO bylaws (Section 5.03) candidates must be:
 - (a) be an individual who is not less than eighteen (18) years of age;
 - (b) be a Member of a Chapter Association for a minimum of two (2) years as a member in good standing;
 - (c) have served on a Committee of the Association or on a Chapter Executive for a minimum of one (1) year;
 - (d) except for Directors appointed pursuant to section 5.06, be a Member of the Association;
 - (e) not be an employee or representative of a company whose primary business involves the development, manufacture and sole distribution of Pharmaceuticals or Medical Devices or care products for older persons;
 - (f) not be an employee or contractor of the Association; and
 - (g) not be a person who has been declared by a court in Canada or elsewhere to be incapable, who has the status of a bankrupt.
- Candidates who meet the above criteria and who have submitted an email noting their intent to stand for nomination prior to the March 15, 2019 deadline, will be asked to submit a brief statement detailing why they are interested in joining the GNAO board. Candidates will also be asked to submit their Curriculum Vitae (CV).
